Journal of Natural Gas Chemistry is covered by Ei Compendex

We announce with pleasure that the *Journal of Natural Gas Chemistry* (JNGC) has been covered by Ei Compendex (Ei) since 2006. Now the first issue of *Journal of Natural Gas Chemistry* this year (in Vol. 15) is available on Ei compendex (<http://www.engineeringvillage2.org.cn>). At the same time, the full texts of JNGC in 2006 (Vol. 15, No. 1) are also available online on ScienceDirect (<http://www.sciencedirect.com/science/journal/10039953>). Engineering Index was founded in 1884 as the first United States literature abstracting and indexing service for the purpose of providing access to and awareness of the world's engineering literature. Engineering Index went online in 1970 with Dialog and Orbit. In 1995 the Ei Engineering Village was introduced, one of the first database web applications in the world, and through the Village, the Compendex Database can be retrieved. The Compendex database currently contains over 7 million abstracts and is growing at the rate of about a quarter of a million records each year. Over 5,000 journals and conference proceedings are reviewed for coverage in Compendex.

We received a letter from Elsevier BV, on January 03, 2006, informing us that JNGC had been covered by some databases. Part of the information from the Elsevier letter is abstracted below:

“In recognition of the high quality and relevance to the scientific community of the journal(s) listed above (JNGC), we are pleased to inform you that your publication(s) has (have) been selected for coverage by Elsevier Bibliographic Databases. These include EMBASE, EMNursing, Compendex, GEOBASE, several specialized niche databases and other derivative products such as Mosby Yearbooks, as well as Scopus. Launched commercially less than a year ago, Scopus, the world largest abstract and indexing database of scientific and social sciences literature, is already firmly established as the all-science database of choice, with more than 8 million users at more than 500 institutions worldwide.”

With the inclusion of JNGC in abstract/indexing databases the dissemination of authors work will greatly increase because sophisticated linking technologies drive additional traffic to individual articles. This in turn promotes journal brand awareness and subscription sales. Meanwhile, with the help of Ei Compendex, ScienceDirect and Elsevier, not only the visibility of JNGC can be remarkably increased, but also international exchanges of valuable information on research, development and utilization of natural gas and its related resources can be obviously enhanced.

We would like to take this chance to express our sincere thanks to all of you who have made great contributions to our JNGC and hope that with your durable supports the *Journal of Natural Gas Chemistry* will be growing up as a qualified international Journal.
